Non-mandatory in EDU-DEX

The EDU-DEX data standard has been set up to make it *easier* for training suppliers and their customers, not more difficult! That is why in EDU-DEX very few fields are mandatory (see above). It is the suppliers and their customers who determine what information they want to exchange. To this end, a very extensive data standard is available; with many dozens of fields that are not mandatory for EDU-DEX, but fields that may be made mandatory by customers. For example, you may enter extensive texts with descriptions of target group, programme objective and programme content. And, of course, there is a lot of space available for entering detailed information about prices and costs: whether or not VAT-taxed, mandatory or optional, etc. The data standard also offers the possibility to enter customer-specific prices. But - again - not mandatory.
